



INFLATION REDUCTION ACT

AT A GLANCE

FROM THE LEGISLATION:

“For quality monitoring to ensure that each home energy efficiency retrofit for which a rebate is provided is documented in a certificate that—

- (A) is provided by the contractor and certified by a third party to the homeowner; and
- (B) details the work performed, the equipment and materials installed, and the projected energy savings or energy generation to support accurate valuation of the retrofit.”

ENERGY EFFICIENT HOME IMPROVEMENT CREDIT

- **ANNUAL LIMIT: \$1,200**
- Up to 30% of qualifying energy efficiency project cost
- \$150 for a home energy audit

HOME OWNER MANAGING ENERGY SAVINGS REBATE PROGRAM

- **LIMIT: \$2,000 - \$4,000**
- Larger rebates for higher energy saving projects
 - Available to All Homeowners

HIGH-EFFICIENCY ELECTRIC HOME REBATE PROGRAM

- **LIMIT: \$1,600**
- Single/Multi Family rebates available for families at or below 150% Area Median Income

HOW CAN I QUALIFY?

Tax credits will be available for home improvements starting in 2023. If you're unsure where your home may fall under this tax season, there are a few resources you can use to find more information in your state, namely your State Energy Office.
